Speed Humps Policy

The following criteria will be used to determine if a street qualifies:

- A street must be a cut-through street.
- A street must be a two-lane, local residential street.
- A street's width must be less than or equal to 25 feet.
- Average Daily Traffic volumes should be greater than 500.
- The speed of at least 15% of the vehicles should be five (5) miles over the posted limit.
- Grade is no greater than 8%
- Street's current speed limit must be posted as 25 mph.
- Street should not be a primary emergency medical services route.

If a street qualifies for speed humps, then the residents must present the Council a petition indicating that at least 75% of all residents on the street and on any adjoining cul-de-sacs support the speed humps. Only if all of these criteria are met will the Town install speed humps. After the petition is accepted by the Council the street will be scheduled for installation of speed humps, normally in the spring, summer or fall of the year when the Town does resurfacing or patchwork. This is in order to keep the costs reasonable.
