Stanley Christmas Parade Rules and Guidelines:

The Town of Stanley's first concern is the safety and care of children, parade participants and the spectators along the parade route.

All parade entries will begin lining up at 1:30 pm on South Main Street.

The parade starts at 3:00 pm on South Main Street at McLurd Drive and ends on Hovis Road at The Stanley Middle School. No entries will be allowed to turn around and drive South during the parade.

All unregistered, untagged and uninsured vehicles must be trailered to the designated staging area and reloaded at the end of the parade. No unregistered, untagged and uninsured vehicles will be allowed on the roadway after the parade ends.

All motorized vehicles that drive in an unsafe manner, including spinning tires and/or doing burnouts will be removed from the parade.

In the event your vehicle breaks down, please pull out of the middle of the street so the parade can continue.

All entry's must enter off of Durham Road, then onto Ethel Drive.

No Entries over 50 Feet.

If child or adult is riding on a float, you must park and walk to float.
