**Annual Wastewater Collection System Performance Report  
FY2023 Annual Report**

**Description**

The Sanitary Sewer Collection System for the Town of Stanley is comprised of approximately 25 miles of gravity sanitary sewer lines, 4 miles of force mains and 12 wastewater pump stations. The purpose of the system is to collect and transport wastewater generated by the Town's 5349 customers to the Two River's Waste Water Treatment Plant.

The Two River's Treatment Plant is owned and operated by the Two River's Utility's City of Gastonia.

**Performance**

The Town's Public Works Department performs the operation and maintenance of the collection system. Our system serves approximately 5349 residents through the 2483 connections on the collection system. There is 1 crew responsible for maintaining our system. One crew is dedicated to the upkeep and maintenance of the Town's 12 wastewater pump stations. This crew visits the stations daily and maintains the stations through cleaning and sludge removal, and is also responsible for line cleaning and videoing sewer lines to make sure we stay in compliance with the state of North Carolina regulations. This crew has cleaned 2.62 miles and videoed 12,300 feet of gravity sewer lines. This crew is also responsible for repairs, easement maintenance, critical area inspections and investigating sewer related problems. There were 18 sewer related incidents in the past year.

There were no reportable spills in the past year.

The Town of Stanley continues to update the Collection System through Capital Improvement Projects.

Pump Station Abandonments- none Pump Replacements- 1. 4<sup>th</sup> St. Pump Station

Currently we are working on replacing sewer lines in the Brevard Basin for I&I and Replacing force main for Meadows lift Station due to age.

The Town of Stanley adopted a Fats, Oil and Grease (FOG) ordinance in April of 2006. This ordinance was put in force to help prevent sanitary sewer blockages and obstructions. This ordinance is also posted on the Town's website under the Public Works department.

The main source of the grease problem is from cooking establishments, but households may also contribute this problem. The cooking establishments are required to have grease traps and grease collection containers. These grease traps and containers should be regularly cleaned and pumped to prevent the grease from entering the sanitary sewer system.

Households should not pour grease or oil down drains or garbage disposals. Grease should be collected in old coffee can or jar and allowed to cool before throwing in the trash. Remember grease blockages can cause wastewater to back up inside homes and damage property.
