Stanley Christmas Parade Rules and Guidelines:

The Town of Stanley's first concern is the safety and care of children, parade participants and the spectators along the parade route.

All parade entries will begin lining up at 1:30 p.m. on South Main Street.

The parade starts at 3:00 p.m. on South Main Street at McLurd Drive and ends on Hovis Road at Stanley Middle School. No entries will be allowed to turn around and drive south during the parade.

All unregistered, untagged and uninsured vehicles must be trailered to the designated staging area and reloaded at the end of the parade. No unregistered, untagged, and uninsured vehicles will be allowed on the roadway after the parade ends.

All motorized vehicles and anything being towed by a motorized vehicle must be driven by a licensed driver.

Any motorized vehicles that drive in an unsafe manner, including spinning tires and/or doing burnouts will be removed from the parade.

In the event your vehicle breaks down, please pull out of the middle of the street so the parade can continue.

Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the lineup. All city, county, and state statutes concerning consumption of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced by the Stanley Police Department.

NO SANTA IMPERSONATORS will be allowed. The Town of Stanley will be providing Santa, no other Santa's will be allowed in the parade.
